Besides the highest quality educational experience, we offer a very competitive rate schedule. Tuition INCLUDES a one-time Application Fee (\$150) and New Enrollment Fee (\$400) for new students; and an Annual Re-enrollment Fee (\$550) for re-enrolling students. (Online processing fees not included)

Multi-Child Discount: This discount is for related children, enrolled in PreK - 8th grade at the same time, who are being paid for by one party. It allows a 5% reduction in the second child’s tuition; 10% in the third child’s tuition; and 15% in tuition for the fourth child. For this calculation, \$550 is deducted first from the tuition.

Full Payment Discount: Many families take advantage of our “Full Payment Discount” by which one can take 5% off the balance owed at contract signing. This full payment plan must be selected in the enrollment form and paid no later than May 2025.

Church Membership Tuition Reduction Policy: As a member of Saint Michael Lutheran Church of Fort Myers, you may be entitled to a 10% reduction in PK3-8th grades’ tuition from the regular rate. ***To qualify for this tuition reduction, the congregation expects each parent to demonstrate their Christian life through—at a minimum— regular worship attendance, support via offerings, and participating in one or more areas of church and school life.***
