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REGISTRATION & FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Enrollment in the Saint Michael Summer Program is open to all, regardless of race, creed, or nationality.

REGISTER NOW: Each Saint Michael Summer Program has a limited enrollment and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis; we are striving for quality, not quantity. Once a program is filled, further applicants will be placed on a waiting list, pending cancellations. We recommend registering early.

A **\$50.00** deposit is required for each program enrolled at time of registration. **The deposit fee is applied to the tuition of the program. The balance of the tuition is due on or before May 28.** For registrations submitted after May 28, the full tuition must be paid at the time of registration. There will be a **\$25 fee for any check returned** to us by the bank because it was unable to be deposited.

REFUNDS: Please note ~ There is no refund for cancellation, either before the program begins or once the week has begun including illness, injury, personal, etc.

PROGRAM CHANGES: There will be a \$25 fee assessed for any changes made after May 28 from your enrolled camp to another camp or week. No changes will be permitted once the camp has begun.

LOCATION: Saint Michael is located at the corner of Broadway and Carrell, two blocks North of the Edison Mall and one block East of U.S. 41.

TRANSPORTATION is the responsibility of the parents.




