Enrollment in the Saint Michael Summer Program is open to all, regardless of race, creed, or nationality.

REGISTER EARLY! Each summer camp has a limited enrollment and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. We strive for quality, not quantity, so once a camp is filled, further applicants will be placed on a waiting list, pending cancellations.

Program changes: There will be a \$25 fee assessed for any changes made after May 25 from your enrolled camp to another camp or week. No changes will be permitted once the camp has begun.
